The Bee Conservancy

Did you know that bees are responsible for pollinating most of the fruits, vegetables, seeds and nuts that are essential to our diets, from apples and squash to buckwheat and coffee? Without bees these foods would not be available. Bees are vital to humans in a number of ways. They are disappearing at an alarming rate and the two main reasons are loss of habitat and the use of pesticides. The Bee Conservancy shares 10 ways you can help save the bees. This is a great opportunity to teach your children the importance of protecting the bee population. The whole family can join the iNaturalist project to share observances and photos that can used in research. You can also start with planting a bee garden to create a safe habitat where bees can flourish. Seek native plants local to your area to provide bees with the plants they have adapted to.
