American Red Cross Blood Services In light of recent events, such as the fires in Hawaii, the American Red Cross is in need of blood donations. You can download the Red Cross app and complete a pre-registration so you can easily schedule appointments and track your donations. There is also a need for plasma donations. Donated plasma is used to treat cancer patients. Every 15 seconds someone needs platelets. Platelets must be used within five days and new donors are needed every day. A platelet donation can provde a full dose of platelets for a patient, sometimes up to three patients.

The Red Cross is also looking for volunteers. By simply entering your zip code you can find the openings available in your area. 90% of the Red Cross workforce are volunteers. Find out how you can do your part.
