- A new application is required with each submission. The employee's printed and signed name must be on the application.
- The employee's 10-digit Enterprise ID must be on the application.
- A copy of the contract with the gym or program. You do not have to send the contract if you are on the same one as previous reimbursements.
- The contract and proof of payment must show the employee's name.
- Proof of payment up to \$200 within the applicable dates (January 1 – June 30, 2024, only)



**Dove Transplant** 

There are approximately 2,000 veterans awaiting a life-saving kidney transplant at either a VA center or military hospital. Donor Outreach for Veterans (DOVE) is a 501c3 organization founded by an experienced and dedicated group of transplant professionals. DOVE seeks to improve access to living kidney transplantation for veterans by facilitating individual and community donor outreach campaigns and providing education, advocacy and support to all donors. DOVE's goal is to find, educate, screen and support prospective living donors and then match those donors to a Veteran awaiting transplant. Donors help complete multiple transplants and therefore their one kidney can save many lives in addition to a veteran's and can undergo the testing and surgery at a participating center closer to their home.
